

General Information for the September 12 – 13, 2008 PCL:YV Workshop

Payment Costs Per Person:

- **Individual Rates:** \$315 CDN (including 5% GST) for CDN participants, OR \$300 US for all other participants.
- **Group Rates (30% discount):** if 5 or more people are attending from the same agency (this does not include professional agencies such as APA, ASTSA, CPA), they will be eligible for the group rate: \$220 CDN (including 5% GST) for CDN participants, OR \$210 US for all other participants.
- **Student Rates (50% discount):** \$158 CDN (including 5% GST) for CDN students, OR \$150 US for all other students.
- *Unfortunately, we are unable to accept credit cards; only cheque or money order please.*

Workshop Facility Information (Rosalind Franklin University of Medicine and Science or RFUMS):

- The workshop will take place in Room 1.702 in the Health Sciences Building of the university.
- The location of the university is 3333 Green Bay Road, North Chicago, IL.
- Each day will run from 9 AM until 4:30 PM, with a coffee break in the morning and afternoon, and a 1-hour lunch break.
- Coffee break refreshments will be provided. Participants are responsible for their own lunches.

What the Workshop Entails:

- Day 1 provides a general overview of the nature and measurement of psychopathy, its implications for the mental health and criminal justice systems, the development of the PCL:YV, including reliability and validity information, and assessment procedures and scoring. Day 2 is devoted to scoring vignettes and practice cases and covering ethical issues and cautions about use.
- This two-day workshop meets the criteria for 14 CE credits. *Multi-Health Systems (MHS) is approved by the American Psychological Association to sponsor continuing education for psychologists. MHS maintains responsibility for this program and its content.*

Workshop Materials:

- Ideally, one should have a PCL:YV manual, but it is not necessary for the workshop.
- To order a PCL:YV manual, you will have to contact the publisher (MHS: www.mhs.com) and ask for a PCL:YV Preview Set (\$142 US), with the special discount for PCL:YV Workshops presented by Darkstone Research Group (15% discount). *Note:* this discount is only for the PCL:YV Preview Set, not the manual alone.
- For those who do not have a copy of the manual, or do not intend to buy one, the scoring criteria will be made available at the workshop and *must* be returned at the end of the final session.
- Other workshop materials (Handouts which include articles, case studies, etc) will be handed out to everyone at the workshop.

Transportation & Parking:

- The university is located in the city of North Chicago, which is approximately 75 minutes north of Chicago (60-90 minutes depending on traffic).
- Parking in the North Parking Lot provides the shortest and most direct walk to the Health Sciences Building. Parking for visitors is free at RFUMS in both the North Parking Lot and the South

Parking Lot. There are also several designated visitor parking places on the West side of the building (near the entrance facing Green Bay Road).

- There are three airports relatively close to the workshop location.
 - Chicago O'Hare Airport - (largest airport, 29 miles from campus) ~ 45 min from RFUMS
 - Chicago Midway Airport - (46 miles from campus, but smaller airlines may have good deals), ~ 60-90 min from RFUMS, depending on traffic
 - Milwaukee: General Mitchell International Airport – (50 miles from campus, sometimes less expensive than Chicago) ~ 46-60 min from RFUMS
- *Travel by train: If staying in a downtown Chicago hotel you can also take the Metra train to RFUMS:*
 - The name of the Metra line that travels to North Chicago is **Union Pacific North**.
 - Please exit the train at the Lake Bluff train station. A RFUMS van meets the trains that arrive at 7:38 and 8:26 AM. The van ride to the university takes approximately 10 minutes.
 - Please let us know if you are taking the Metra. We can also provide transportation back to the Lake Bluff train station at the end of the day.
- Travel by taxi: From Chicago's O'Hare or Midway airports, the cheapest taxi is American Taxi (1-847-255-9600). Taxi fares are \$63 one-way from Midway and \$39.50 one-way from O'Hare. Taxis from Milwaukee General Mitchell Airport are expensive (\$120-130 with Veteran Taxi Cab), so it may be more economical to rent a car.
- Shuttles from the airports are also available. You may want to consider checking http://www.chicagotraveler.com/chicago_airports.htm and clicking on "shuttles". This site gives you a number of options for transportation to/from the airports. Remember to reserve yourself a seat in advance.

Hotels:

- It is possible to stay in a hotel in downtown Chicago (see Transportation). Here we list hotel options closer to the workshop location with the distance from RFUMS listed parenthetically.
